## THE NONPROFIT DIFFERENCE

A.G. Rhodes is one of Atlanta's oldest nonprofit organizations and has set the standard for serving an aging community since 1904. As one of only a few mission-driven, nonprofit nursing home providers in Georgia, our nonprofit status is a fundamental difference in our approach to care. We're able to direct more resources into the care we provide, including our state-of-the-art therapy and rehabilitation services, our innovative programming, and our diverse activities and events. Our legacy and reputation, culture of compassion, and mission-driven approach allow us to recruit and retain exceptional employees, resulting in lower staff turnover, and higher staff and resident satisfaction.

### KEY FACTS

- Our three homes in Fulton, DeKalb and Cobb counties have the combined capacity to serve more than 400 residents and served nearly 1,150 seniors last fiscal year.
- A.G. Rhodes is 100% Medicare and Medicaid certified. Medicaid covers much, but not all, of the health care costs of those staying at A.G. Rhodes. Philanthropy from the community helps with expenses that are not covered.
- Revenues and expenses were approximately \$45 million.
- Combined occupancy rate was approximately 88%.
- We provide short-term and long-term care:
  - Sub-acute care/rehab/short-term recovery: 20%
  - Long-term care: 80%

Although COVID-19 has impacted our volunteer program, our volunteers served nearly 6,900 hours filling more than 1,500 volunteer opportunities from July 2019 until we suspended in-person volunteer activities in March 2020. We will resume in-person activities when it is safe to do so, and we continue seeking other meaningful ways that our volunteers and the community can help support our residents and staff.
