We have a formal affiliation agreement with WellStar Health System. A WellStar Medical Director and Geriatric Nurse Practitioner provide onsite medical services. This partnership helps to foster a seamless continuum of care between inpatient and post-acute services.

Eden Alternative Registry

Became the first stand-alone nursing home in the state to be accepted into the Eden Alternative Registry, which consists of 250 national and international long-term care communities committed to improving the quality of life and care for the people they serve.



Rhodes to Home

Last fiscal year, the Rhodes to Home program helped nearly 170 individuals successfully transition from living at A.G. Rhodes to living back in their communities independently or with some assistance.
