A.G. Rhodes was one of the first nursing organizations to be licensed in Georgia and is currently one of a few nonprofit nursing organizations in the state. As one of Atlanta's oldest nonprofit organizations, our roots trace back more than a century ago when Amos Giles Rhodes came to Atlanta and founded Rhodes Furniture. He donated the land and funds for A.G. Rhodes' first location, which opened in 1904 at the corner of Boulevard and Woodward Avenue where our flagship location still operates today.
